November's Look at a Glance

In Social Studies we will be learning about our rights and responsibilities regionally and globally. Along with learning about their rights and responsibilities in the classroom and school, your child will learn about their responsibility within our community and beyond.

During guided reading, we are continuing to read a variety of fiction texts while practicing several reading strategies. Your child is learning the importance of self-monitoring to ensure what they are reading is making sense. During writer's workshop, your child is continuing to learn how to create different types of writing to deepen their awareness of self, family and their community. Along with personal narrative and opinion writing, we will begin the letter writing process.

Our Math rotations continue with number sense and patterns within numbers as the focus. The Grade 2's are working on numbers 1 through 100 while the Grade 3's are working with numbers up to 1000.

Mathletics is up and running and is a great way to review and supplement concepts covered in class. It is very popular in the class and students are able to, and encouraged, to use it at home.

Fresh Grade

This is a reminder that Fresh Grade is up and running. Through Fresh Grade I can send you "real time" pictures of your child's work, activities in the class or field trip excursions. In addition, audio and video recordings can be sent so you can hear or see what your child is up to throughout the day in the classroom. I am new to the program but as the year goes on I am hoping to become more familiar and comfortable with it.
